#013 is a fine example of form following function. It's made for playing. But it sports just enough visual pizzazz to not go unnoticed. It's slender profile, low weight (due to heavy in-body chambering), low action, fast neck, tone-enhancing Babicz Full Contact bridge and Bill Lawrence's hum-free, crystalline blade pickups (Tele in the bridge, strat in the neck) complete a versatile, understated and very refined workhorse tone machine.

This is arguably the most playable guitar to come out of JGS Guitars to date.
