

Multiscale Myrtlewood-topped T3 Africaster

Figured Myrtlewood is light and resonant. Putting a cap of this on a heavily chambered Sapele Mahogany body delivers a featherweight guitar with striking, crisp resonance, even when unplugged. The multiscale fingerboard gives a standard tone in the bass strings that you would expect from a tele-style guitar, but the high E, at 24.5 inches, sings through the mix with a real clarity. The result is a beautifully balanced sound with a bit of twang in the bridge and a woody, strat-like presence in the neck pickup. This is a real solo player's guitar.
