This multiscale Africaster sports the very best of African woods with not a little arrogance. Wax-melt Tamboti top and fingerboard, African Blackwood details and a flame Hard Pear neck make it the most African of the Africasters. And it works hard too. The multiscale neck gives the lower strings an extra pound of flesh and lets the high E and B defy gravity as they cut through the mix. The slightly hotter-than-average tele stacked pickups are from the hand-made factory of octogenerian pickup guru Bill Lawrence. They can growl when required but retain that sweet, clean, hum-free tele sound when you're happy to lower your voice.
