

### T3 Africaster in Red Bushwillow

Serial # 020

This is probably the world's first guitar with a red bushwillow (*Combretum apiculatum*) top - a gorgeous, rock-hard wood that has yet to be discovered by the luthery community. It carries a standard strat wiring, driving Kent Armstrong vintage Texas voiced pickups, and sports a super-low, fast action on a narrow profile neck. Built for comfort and for speed.
